The UK Government roadmap for lifting lockdown means people in England can walk outside in groups of six from Monday 29th March. The national organisation, the Ramblers Association, are working towards starting organised group walks from Monday 12th April (Roadmap Step.2 - numbers yet to be agreed). If local lockdown guidelines allow the undermentioned rambles have been planned. As required, a Risk Assessment of compliance to the latest Government guidelines at the time of the walk will be carried out.

### **Sunday 18th April**

The 10 mile walk starts at 10am from the car park at Monkton Combe by the Wheelwrights Arms BA2 7HB. The ramble follows in part the Limestone Link to Combe Hay and the return along a Fosse Way to South Stoke and then to the outskirts of Combe Down.

### **Sunday 9th May**

The 'Wisteria' walk starts from the railway car park in Bradford on Avon at 10am. Free all-day parking Zone 'B'.

The ramble is approx. 9 miles and proceeds to Farleigh Hungerford and then north on the Macmillan Way to Iford Manor.

The return to B-o-A is via Freshford, Avoncliff and along the Kennet & Avon canal towpath.
