Sunday 21st April

The walk of approximately 8 miles starts at 10am from the Long Street Car Park (free parking) in Dursley GL11 4HR/Grid Ref ST 758 983. The ramble follows the Cotswold Way along the escarpment over Peaked Down and Cam Long Down. The route descends into Uley and continues along a quiet lane to the secluded hamlet of Owlpen and then beside the little River Ewelme before the return.

Suggest car sharing where possible. Please bring a picnic lunch.

Optional refreshments after the walk in the Bank Café opposite the Market House in town.

Sunday 12th May

The 'Bluebell Walk' starts at 10am from The Who'd A Thought It pub at Lockeridge, near Marlborough SN8 4EL with plenty of on-street parking nearby.

The walk of approx. 9 miles passes thro' West Woods and onward to the Pewsey Downs via the White Horse Trail.

Where possible please car share by private arrangement.

Please bring a picnic lunch.

Optional post-walk refreshments in the pub.
