Sunday 18th May

The 'Wisteria Walk' of approx.9 miles starts from The Mill at Rode car park BA11 6AG at 10am. The ramble passes thro' Tellisford, Farleigh Hungerford and then to Westwood before the scenic return home via Iford, continuing south along the MacMillan Way following in part the River Frome.

At the lunch stop an opportunity to enjoy the wisteria blooms and visit the cafe at Iford. Alternatively bring a picnic lunch.
