Sunday 19th October

Meet 10 am outside the Catherine Wheel Public House, Marshfield SN14 8LR. Park thoughtfully on the High Street. Please car share as limited parking.

The walk of approx 9 miles heads for Bellum, along the valley, then a steep climb to Cold Ashton. The walk follows part of the Limestone link through the St Catherine Valley with a glimpse of St Catherine's Court, returning via Ashwick and Halldoor Lane. Some steep terrain, lots of lovely views.

Please bring a picnic lunch.

Optional post walk refreshments in the pub.

Sunday 16th November

The 10 mile ramble starts from Chew Magna at 10am.

Parking (free) in the public car park behind the Pelican Inn BS40 8SL. Car sharing is encouraged. Meet across the road on the pavement outside St. Andrew's Church.

The route takes us along the pretty Two Rivers Way to Stanton Drew with its impressive Neolithic Stone Circle. English Heritage would love you to bring £1 cash for their honesty box at the Stone Circle.

En route views of Pensford Viaduct and the Somerset Levels. The walk continues to Chew Lake and then the return to Chew Magna along the River Chew seeing remnants of the wool industry.

Afterwards optional refreshments in the pub.
